## The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy Addendum as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through Parent Mail texts, the school website, weekly assemblies and welfare calls.

## To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- If my child, or another child in the bubble, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;
  - I will ensure my child wears clean school uniform every day.  
Girls: blue and white dress.  
Boys: white t-shirt and dark shorts
  - On the way to and from school and when dropping my child off, I will stick to the 2 meter social distancing rules.
  - I will complete the data collection form upon arrival at school on the first morning.
  - I will wait until my child's temperature has been taken.
  - I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child, when dropping off and picking up.
  - My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school, other than packed lunch (if needed) and a bottle of water.
  - I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules.
  - My child will need to use good hygiene rules.
  - I will not be allowed into the school building - I must make contact via phone or email
  - I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis;
  - I will read all letters/messages that are sent home;
  - I will inform the school immediately of any changes to parent/carers and emergency contacts details.
  - If my child is deemed unsafe, I understand that he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.
  - If anyone in my family does not follow social distancing guidance, my child will lose the provision.

- Follow good hand hygiene - use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these rules to help keep myself, my friends and my teachers safe.
